### **CONDITIONS**

- The parents'/guardians' joint monthly income may not exceed R15 000;
- Recipients must do voluntary community work for at least one week during the year in which they receive a bursary from the Fund;
- No bursaries are awarded to previous recipients who failed the relevant academic year and/or neglected to do the required amount of voluntary community work.
